Please read this piece of scripture a couple of times and reflect on the message of it. For each piece of scripture, you will need to answer the first 3 questions into your recording book. Question 4 is optional:

- What do you think the key message of this piece of scripture is? Why?
- What might be meant by be still?
- What could you do perhaps today or this week to help live out this message?
- Can you draw a story board or complete a comic strip of a situation that might show somebody following the advice from the scripture below.
