### Why not help your child enjoy reading?

Children are taking a book home every day. We ask you to keep up the support in sharing the book with your child, talking about the pictures, asking them to predict outcomes and retell the story. Phonics learning is ongoing and we encourage you to talk about initial sounds and common words used frequently, e.g Mum and Dad, own name etc.

### Look what we're doing in our R.E. topics

**Myself** – children will be able to wonder about why their name is important and will recognise that God knows and loves each person by name

**Welcome** – children will learn about Baptism as the way they are welcomed into God's church.



**Birthdays** – children learn about the joy of celebrating a birthday. They will recognise the Nativity story and signs that indicate the approach of Christmas.
