LO: To be able to describe and give examples of ways we can be thanksgiving for God's love.

St Paul wrote to his friends in Thessalonika to encourage and reassure them. He told them that God's love, mercy, forgiveness and compassion are all gifts for them. We thank God for the gifts he gives us just as we thank friends for the gifts they give us. God gives us all the gifts we need to help us to live good lives.
