



## School Performance 2016



The Governing body is required by the Education Reform Act 1988 to publish the School's National Curriculum Statutory Assessment Results. In primary school, such assessments are made and tests are taken at age 6/ 7 (year 2) - Key Stage 1 and at age 10/11 (year 6) - Key Stage 2.

### KS2 results Nationally

These results relate to pupils attaining 100 scaled score. The combined scores mean that a pupil must have gained 100 scaled score in both reading and Mathematics, and have met the expected standard in writing.

### High Score Nationally

These results relate to pupils attaining a scaled score of 110+ (a high level of attainment)
